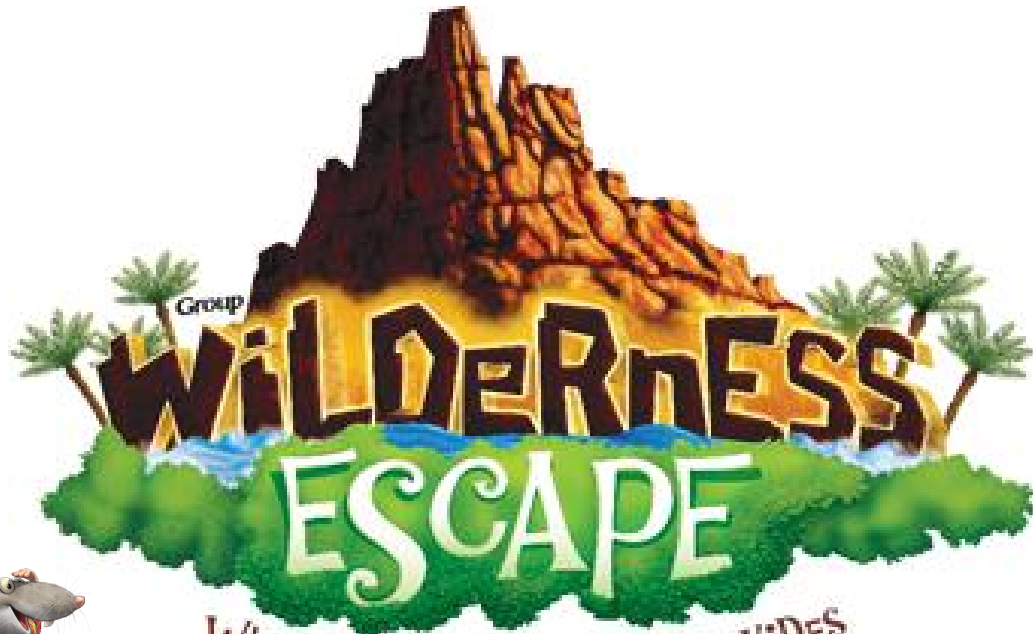

Our mission project for VBS is books for kids and here's how you can help make this a success! New or gently used books for kids of elementary



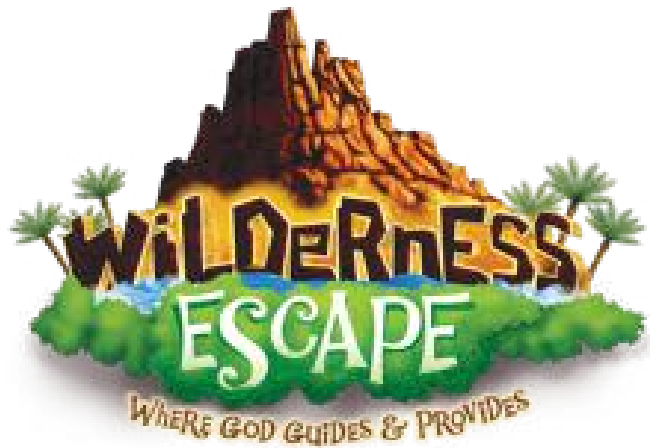

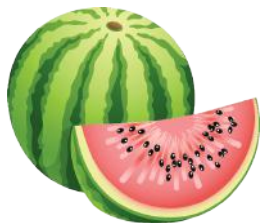
