

All congregations of the ELCA are encouraged to participate in the ELCA's "40 Days of Giving," a Lenten journey to explore together an answer to the question, "What will it take to end hunger?" This is not a thought experiment, but a question asking where and how we are to be the church in a world where 690 million people are undernourished. In these 40 days, we remember our spiritual forebears and their long journey from slavery in Egypt to liberation in the Promised Land. We commemorate Jesus' solitude in the wilderness and recall His journey to the cross.

Our fasting and prayer in this season remind us of our dependence on God and our longing for the fulfillment of God's promises for God's world. In the last year, we've seen the number of hungry people around the world rise, as it has for the last five years. We've watched as hunger ministries have expanded to serve an ever-growing number of guests. And we have longed together in hope for the time when we "will hunger no more, and thirst no more...and God will wipe away every tear from [our] eyes" (Rev 7:16-17).

During this Lenten season, you are encouraged to remember the "40 Days of Giving" to ELCA World Hunger and set a goal for your giving. A gift of \$2 a day can make a significant impact on someone who is facing hunger. Consider setting aside that amount through this Lenten season to donate to ELCA World Hunger.



# Grand Opening of Indoor Services Sunday, May 2nd






We look forward to welcoming you back to worship in-person and in the sanctuary on May 2nd at 10:00 am!
