VBS DAY 1

Today's Theme: Roots of Creation

"What a wildly wonderful world God! You made it all so wisely."

Psalm 104:24

Bible Story: On the first day we read a Psalm. A psalm is a song to God, just like the songs we are singing in this worship service today. Psalms, like songs, can be happy or sad, silly or serious. Psalm 104 is thanking God for all God created, from the highest mountains to the deepest oceans, from the birds that fly to the fish that swim, from tiny insects to huge elephants to each one of us. God made all creatures different and blessed them with gifts. We learned how we can help heal God's creation and how God's creation helps heal us. Creation shows us that God loves to create and play, and we can play and create too.

World Hunger Program: We traveled to Eswatini, a small country in the southeast corner of Africa, about the size of New Jersey. We met a boy who had trouble concentrating in school sometimes because he was hungry. A church in his community started a garden project to help people grow their own fresh, healthy vegetables. Because of the garden, the boy can now get the food he needs for his body to grow and his family can trade and sell the vegetables for other foods, like chickens. By working with our neighbors and other churches, we can be part of God's work in the world, helping everyone enjoy the gifts of creation and the healthy lives God wants for us.

VBS DAY 2

Today's Theme: Healthy Minds and Body

"Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, just as it is well with your soul."

3 John 1:1

Bible Story: On the second day we read from the book of 3rd John in the New Testament. We learned that the whole book is a letter that was written by an elder - an elder is a leader in the church, like a pastor. The letter was written to a friend of the elder named Gaius. The elder prays the Gaius will be healthy in his body and his soul. He also tells his friend to be like the good people he sees and not the mean or dishonest people. This story reminds us to be thankful for all of the people we love and those who love us. God wishes us to have not just healthy bodies but also healthy minds, relationships and lives. As part of our Bible Time, we wrote our own letters just like this letter in the Bible to tell someone in our lives that we are thankful for them, and we wish them to be healthy in mind, body and heart. God teaches us to care for our loved ones and this is one way we can do it - by telling them we are thankful for them!

World Hunger Program: God created us with all kids of emotions for all kinds of situations. For our second day, we traveled to South Sudan and learned about a family

who went through some challenges after they moved to Egypt. The two girls in the family were having trouble in school because their parents were sad and overwhelmed and struggling to make enough money for the family. A group called St. Andrew's Refugee Services, helped the family by paying for the children to go to school and providing money for transportation and counseling. God wants us to help others to be healthy and hopeful for their future.

This program was especially important during the pandemic when people with medical problems had to stay home to be safe. Our church supported delivery of meals to these people's homes. God's love is always with us in the food we share and the friendships we make. God is with us when we share food and make sure everyone has enough to eat.

The Rice Street Garden is supported by our church and has 250 garden plots. Many of the plots are planted and maintained by refugee

families that are new to our country and helps them to grow food, practice their English and belong to a community. When we work together to make sure everyone is healthy and welcomed, we can see God working through us in amazing ways.
