

#### TUESDAY WOMEN'S STUDY RESUMES IN SEPT

Beginning Tuesday, September 13<sup>th</sup> – 10 am

All women are invited to join us, in-person in the Fellowship Hall, or virtually via a Zoom connection, when we resume our regular Tuesday Women's Bible study time.

We begin with new material from women's Bible study author, Melissa Spoelstra. This study centers on Isaiah, a prophet who served as God's mouthpiece to the people of God and the surrounding nations. Isaiah's message reverberates through our lives today as we read his call to rely on the Lord, to strive less and trust God more.

On Sunday, September 11, Living Water will partner with the Northeast Valley Consortium congregations to assemble hygiene kits for foster children/youth. Our kits will go to Arizona Helping Hands to help foster kids be healthy and feel confident. Arizona Helping Hands is the largest provider of essential necessities for children in foster care in the State. See more at <a href="mailto:azhelpinghands.org">azhelpinghands.org</a>. More than 14,000 Arizona children are in out-of-home care, the majority of which are ages 1 to 5 years. More than 34% of children spend over 12 months in care.

Each kit will include a hair brush or comb, hair ties for girls, kids 3-in-1 (shampoo/conditioner/bodywash), kids' toothpaste, kids' toothbrush, dental floss. We'll pack these items into a colorful reusable drawstring bag.

Thanks to everyone for their donations to support this activity. And thanks to Thrivent for a Thrivent Action Team grant of \$250 to help us purchase needed items.






We are planning to plant several new trees to replace the ones lost in the wind storm at the end of July.


