

CAROLYN TONNESON OBITUARY

Of St. Paul, Minnesota Died December 1, 2022, after a short and difficult battle with cancer. Carolyn was born October 30, 1946, to Selma (Rosenberg) Heuer and William C.F. Heuer in Bertha, Minnesota. She grew up on a farm near Bertha and attended Bertha-Hewitt School, where she graduated as valedictorian in 1964. Carolyn attended Concordia College, Moorhead, Minnesota, graduating with honors in Elementary Education and Music in 1967. She



met her husband, Jim Tonneson, at Concordia and they were married June 24,1967 in Bertha. Jim was a seminarian and the couple lived in many cities in Minnesota, North Dakota, and Washington, where Carolyn worked as a second grade teacher and as a piano teacher. During this time, Carolyn and Jim welcomed three children, Mark, Scott, and Kimi. In 1982, Carolyn earned her master's degree in counseling from North Dakota State University. She became a clinical social worker and marriage and family therapist for Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota and was later named Regional Vice President. She also owned a consulting business and held several executive positions with nonprofit organizations. At the age of 72, Carolyn fulfilled a lifelong dream of volunteering overseas, spending a month in Mombasa, Kenya. Upon her return, she founded the nonprofit Peter's Hope so that she and Peter Ochieng, the director of the school and women's center, could work together to bring better opportunities for education and empowerment to the children and women of Bamburi, Kenya. Carolyn loved many things: traveling, reading, music and the arts, her church, her nonprofit, and most of all—her family. Carolyn just plain loved life and tried to live each day with a positive attitude. She gives credit to the Divine for each and every opportunity she had to touch the lives of other people. Carolyn was preceded in death by her parents; brothers Don and Jerry; and sister Mona. She is survived by her husband, Jim; children, Mark (Tami), Scott (Jennifer Thorson), and Kimi; two grandchildren, Owen and Noah; and sister and brothers Maxine, Wally, Jim, and Chuck. She is also survived by many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. on Thursday, December 8, 2022, at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in St. Paul, with a reception to follow at the church. 




Piecemakers Quilters in December



Want to try your hand at making Lefse (lef'-suh), a Norwegian flatbread made from potatoes, butter & cream, traditionally made during the holidays?




