

Note: The Dennis Nelson Bible Study will be on a three month break for summer starting in June and will resume again in September.




Prayer Shawl Ministry






We'll meet in the Estrem building meeting room (behind the registration desk). Coffee (and hot water for tea) and muffins



The Living Water Lutheran VBS mission project for 2024 is again collecting new and "gently-used" books, **especially books for children from kindergarten through 8th grade**. A "gently-used" book is defined by Ima Bookworm as one with 1) no rips or tears, 2) no writing, and 3) no worm holes. Your donation may be the first book owned by a fortunate student!




