




The Service and Caring Team Ministry at LWLC periodically determines how to distribute offerings to the Hunger Jar. Most recently, we split the 12/31/24 balance of \$1,899.00 between Foothills Food Bank and ELCA World Hunger. Each received \$944.50.

While the jar's tag line says, "Change for Change," your offering can be coins, bills, and even checks.
